

Hourly pay gap

About median and mean

Women earn £1.07p for every £1 that men earn when comparing median hourly pay. Their median hourly pay is 7.4% higher than men's.

When comparing mean (average) hourly pay, women's mean hourly pay is 4.2% lower than men's.

The percentage of women in each quarter

About pay quarters

Women occupy 22.1% of the highest paid jobs and 19.5% of the lowest paid jobs.

Bonus Gap

Women earn £1.55 for every £1 than men earn when comparing median bonus pay. Their median bonus pay is 55.6% higher than men's.

When comparing mean (average) bonus pay, women's mean bonus pay is 22% lower than men's.
